



DAY 2 CRAFT

WHAT YOU NEED: Paper towel and/or toilet paper rolls; paper plates; scissors; tape; marbles (or small pebbles or balls), and any other “found” objects around your home

IN THE TAKEOVER BOX: Tape; marbles (or ping pong balls)

WHAT YOU DO:

- Set out all supplies.
- Tell kids to design and build a series of towers, ramps, and loops that marbles can roll through.
- Encourage them to create the most unique track possible for their marbles.
- Let kids test their designs to see if marbles can make their way through the entire thing.
- Allow kids to play with their creations.



WHAT YOU SAY:

"Life can be full of twists and turns like your marble tower. However, God is always with you. Life is hard for everyone, and telling others about what we believe can point them toward God during those hard times—and during the good times as well! What are some ways you can tell others about what you believe? *(Pause for responses.)* **[Bottom Line]** You can TALK with others about what you believe."
