



DAY 4 CRAFT

WHAT YOU NEED: paper cup, scissors, string, tape, large paper, paint, drop cloth (something to protect the floor), 2 chairs and a broom (or any material that you can use to make a structure to hang the pendulum)

IN THE TAKEOVER BOX: paper cup, string, tape, large paper, paint

For a cleaner project set up on the driveway and put WATER in your cup!

WHAT YOU DO:

- Prep the workspace by covering the floor with a drop cloth or sheet.
- Prep the pendulum by poking a hole on the bottom of the cup and one hole on each side under the rim. Tie a piece of string through the 2 holes on the side of the cup creating a handle for the cup.
- Place the broom horizontally between the 2 chairs and tie the string with the cup on the middle of the broom. (it should be hanging by the string and not touching the ground) (you can use wood, Legos, a tree branch, and many other items to make this structure)
- Place a piece of tape covering the bottom hole of the cup and fill the cup with paint (If your paint is thin, you may have to add water)
- Place your paper underneath the pendulum.
- Remove the tape and swing the cup. As you observe the pendulum making patterns on the paper, discuss what you learned this week and think about people that you can talk to about what you believe!
- Follow the steps above to create several more pictures to share with others.
