Look over each day and choose how to engage in a 5-10-minute conversation as a family.

## FAMILY DISCUSSION DAY 1

Your child learned about seeing God in creation.

## FAMILY DISCUSSION DAY 2

Your child learned about Peter saying that Jesus is the Messiah.

Matthew 16:13-20

Do you have any questions about who Jesus is?

Have you ever done anything that you feel you should ask Jesus for forgiveness for?

Would you like to talk about that now?



## FAMILY DISCUSSION DAY 3

Your child learned about the greatest commandment.

Matthew 22:36-40: 1 Corinthians 13

Tell your child some things that they do that show you that they love you, then ask "how do I show you that I love you?"

How can we show that love to others?

Why is it important to love God first?



## FAMILY DISCUSSION DAY 4

Your child learned about applying FOCUS to their life.

Remind your child that they can always trust you with faith conversations and questions.

How can you tell other people about Jesus?

Has this experience changed the way that you look at God?
