Seek & Find

What You Need: Small household items (rubber-band, paper clip, Lego, Barbie shoe, etc.), tape, Sensory Bag

In the TAKEOVER Box: Tape, Sensory Bag

What You Do:

- Gather small household items to add to your sensory bag.
- Tape the zip top bag closed.
- Have kids race against the clock to see how many items they can locate in a min.
- Another variation for younger kids would be to play like I spy and see what treasures you can find.

What You Say:

“Great job, guys and girls! You looked like you had a great time playing this game. In the game, you had to talk with your teammates to locate the hidden items. Just like you were able to talk through the game, **[Bottom Line] you can TALK with others about what you believe.** That may be hard to do at times, but God has given us His Holy Spirit to give us courage as well as the words to say. **[Make It Personal] (Talk about a time when you spoke about what you believe with others.)** When we talk about what we believe, our friends can hear all about how God loves them, too.”
