UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Review this week's message.

Key Scriptures: Nehemiah 7:4-6; Nehemiah 7:8-63; Nehemiah 7:1-3; Deuteronomy 6:14-15

1. Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What did you think of based on the quote Brandon shared, "People don't care what you do, but they will buy into why you are doing it?
- Any examples of that in your life? (Example what: Extreme Week; Why: to impact kids' lives here on earth and to impact where they will spend eternity)

2. Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- What was Nehemiah trying to accomplish?
- Why was Nehemiah focused on what he was doing?
- What do you have in your sermon notes that impacted you?

3. Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Share about a time when you were inspired by WHY something was happening, and you joined in.
- Nehemiah appointed Hananiah, "because he was a man of integrity and feared God more than most people do." How would people describe you? On your best day? On your worst day?

4. Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

- Very likely, people shared needs, and thoughts, or described themselves in ways that you could pray for them during your discussion time. Pray for those needs.
- Ask if anyone has any prayer requests and make note of them so that none are missed.

5. Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Find one way to praise God for what He has given you to do and why it will impact the Kingdom of God every day this week. Share one next week with the group.
- Express to someone this week (family, friend, co-worker etc.) WHY God has impacted your life. They might have questions or even want to experience Mosaic with you! Either is a win!
