Key Scriptures: Haggai 2:8; Matthew 25:14; Nehemiah 7:70-73

- 1. Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.
 - Did you grow up knowing your father?
 - What was his best attribute?
 - His weakest attribute?

1. Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- In wealth management, there is the owner and the manager of the money that has been invested. What is the difference between the owner and the manager?
- If God owns it all, does He get to determine what you do with what's left after you meet your needs? Or what's left after you meet your needs and then invest in your wants? Or does He get to determine what you do with all of His money, even in the face of growing needs and wants?
- What distinguishes between something you need and something you want?

2. Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Share about a time when you gave joyfully. (It may have been to a stranger, to a friend, to the church, to family, etc.)
- What does it mean to provide for our families spiritually? (As husbands? As wives? As parents? When you're single?)

3. Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray for those in your group that may be facing great needs.
- Pray that God transforms broken lives into brand-new lives, and gives us wisdom as we invest in His Kingdom.

4. Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Take out the card that you received at Mosaic this week, and pray that God confirms what you are to invest in the future of Mosaic missions on the Gulf Coast.
